October 1, 2015 — The Board of Public Works is pleased to appoint Gabe Gnall as Procurement Advisor. Mr. Gnall currently serves as Procurement Chief at the Department of Budget and Management.

The Procurement Advisor:

- examines all procurements within Board of Public Works jurisdiction
- coordinates communication among procurement agencies
- advises and implements best practices in State procurement
- investigates complaints
- prepares reports on State procurement
- staffs the Procurement Advisory Council
- chairs the Council for the Procurement of Health, Educational, & Social Services



In his position as DBM Procurement Chief, Mr. Gnall has both conducted and supervised large-scale service procurements, including health benefits, employee services, and facilities management contracts. He has also developed standardized practices and documents for diverse agencies to use. He is familiar to State procurement practitioners as the leader of the Senior Procurement Advisors' Group.

Mr. Gnall first worked as a systems engineer upon graduating from St. Vincent College in Pennsylvania. After a few years, he enrolled in the Widener University School of Law in Delaware from which he received his law degree. Mr. Gnall is a member of the Maryland Bar. He resides with his (growing) family in Bowie, Prince George's County.
