Remarks:

1. Four grants (Acts of 2021) were amended by Chapter 626, Acts of 2022 to change the project name from “Maenner House” to “Guide Right Facility”. This was a previously approved agenda item on 10/12/2022, 30-CGL, subsequently amended as noted in Remark 2.
2. Four grants (Acts of 2021) were amended by SB 966, Chapter 722, Acts of 2024 to change the grantee name and project name from the “Huntington City Community Development Corporation” for the “Guide Right Facility” project to the “Board of Directors of the Diamond Foundation of Prince George’s County, Inc.” for the “Diamond Foundation of Prince George’s County” project.
3. One grant (Acts of 2022) was amended by SB 966, Chapter 722, Acts of 2024 to change the grantee name from “Huntington City Community Development Corporation” to the “Board of Directors of Diamond Foundation of Prince George’s County, Inc.”; and the grant project name from “Old Town Bowie – Historical Properties” to “Diamond Foundation of Prince George’s County”. This was previously approved agenda item on 10/12/2022, 31-CGL.
4. One grant (Acts of 2023), DGS is administratively correcting the grantee name from Board of Directors of The Bowie-Mitchellville Diamond Foundation, Inc. to the Board of Directors of the Diamond Foundation of Prince George’s County, Inc.; and the grantee project name from The Bowie-Mitchellville (MD) Diamond Foundation Center to Diamond Foundation of Prince George’s County, pursuant to Section 1 (9) of Senate Bill 361 of 2024.



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5. This action is in accordance with the enabling legislation and complies with the tax- exempt bond provisions of the Internal Revenue Code.
6. The grant recipient shall consult with the Maryland Historical Trust pursuant to Sections 5A-325 to 328, State Finance and Procurement Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, and convey a perpetual preservation easement pursuant to the terms of the enabling legislation.
7. Procurement/Contracts should be submitted to the Department of General Services for eligibility determination.
8. This project may include the acquisition of a property in Bowie, MD.
