The restoration of the HOA's existing marsh and sand shoreline along the South River near Thomas Point in Anne Arundel County has been a major community initiative for approximately five years. Considerable expense and an abundance of community volunteer effort has been expended to bring this project to fruition.

The restoration of a living shoreline along the confluence of the Chesapeake Bay and the South river will provide numerous benefits to include:

- · Halting existing erosion of the natural shoreline, currently receding more than six-inches per year
- Re-establish and invigorate a distinct living shoreline in accordance with best practices as advocated by the Maryland Department of the Environment
- Protect an existing freshwater pond and it's environs that serve as habitat for over 20 species of domestic and migratory birds and waterfowl
